Foundation 2 – End of reception

72.7% of the cohort achieved a Good Level of Development (GLD). Good level of development nationally: 71.5%.

Year 1 Phonics test (45 pupils)

84% of the year 1 cohort passed the test. The overall national figure for 2018 was 83%. By the end of Year 2 95.6% passed the phonics test. National figure was 92%

Year 6 – End of Key Stage 2

Below are the results from the SATs taken by our year 6 children in May 2018.

40 year 6 pupils sat standardised tests in reading, grammar, punctuation and spelling (GPS) and maths, writing was assessed by the class teachers. One child did not sit the end of Year 6 SATs tests.
