Foundation 2 – End of reception

65% of the cohort achieved a Good Level of Development (GLD) which was lower than the national figure of 71%.

Year 1 Phonics test (45 pupils)

67% of the year 1 cohort passed the test. The overall national figure for 2016 was 82%. By the end of Year 2 89% passed the phonics test, with 50% of those who retook the test passing. National figure was 90%

Year 6 – End of Key Stage 2

Below are the results from the SATs taken by our year 6 children in May 2017.

41 year 6 pupils sat standardised tests in reading, grammar, punctuation and spelling (GPS) and maths, writing was assessed by the class teachers.
