Music

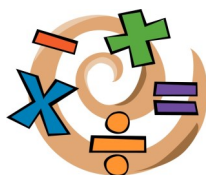
Children will explore different instruments and look at how instruments are made out of different materials. We will look at music skills including pitch and dynamics.

Children will continue to develop their maths skills.

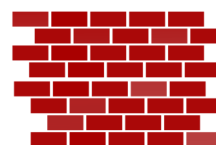
This term we are focusing on multiplication and fractions.

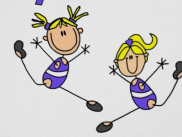

- Use real life situations to support numeracy eg: shopping and time.
- Help your child research any of the above.
- Help your child with My Maths / Spellings homeworks which are set.
- Time - Please encourage your child to practise telling the time at home.
