
Kingfishers, Skylarks & Falcons - Summer Term Newsletter 2019

Maths

PSHE will be looking at issues related to the wider world such as rights and responsibilities and taking care of the environment.


Geography

This will link to the topics. We will be playing tuned and un-tuned instruments and controlling sounds through singing and playing. We will be learning about the history of music.




ICT
