

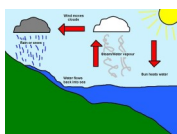
# NEWSLETTER - SPRING TERM 2017

We will be looking at how animals begin life along with animal life cycles and water cycles.

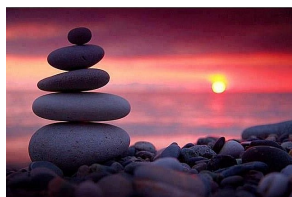
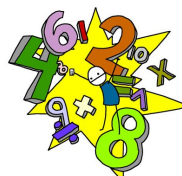


### Literacy
