Subsidised after school or breakfast club places.	To provide pupils with BSED needs the opportunity to access after school provision
Purchase ICT software – My Maths, Reading eggs, Purple Mash	To use web-based learning programs to extend learning outside of the classroom to the home, via the internet.
TA support for switch on reading intervention programme, 4 x afternoons per week x 36 weeks (2 TA's)	20-minute, 10 week, 1:1 personalised literacy intervention (KS1 & KS2) to support underachieving vulnerable pupils who are working below age related expectation in literacy learning.
TA support for nurture time, 4 x mornings per week.	To provide support and nurture for pupils with BSED and SEN needs, so that they are able to fully access school life. To provide counselling and mentoring where needed.
High quality CPD for staff linked to school development plan)	To deepen the skills, knowledge and understanding of teaching assistants in the teaching of reading and writing. To develop skills in food hygiene.
Subsidised school trips, visits and events	To enable all pupils to participate in all school trips.
MDSA lunch club – focused games and activities.	To provide opportunities for vulnerable pupils to access structured activities at lunch time.
Think Children	To provide 1:1 intervention to pupils aged 4-11 who are displaying signs of emerging social, emotional or behavioural issues
1:1 support for Literacy and Numeracy, AM sessions with (3) TA's 4 x week (Power of 1 and Power of 2)	To improve outcomes for all pupils in school, particularly those children who are underachieving and SEN.
1:1 Literacy and Numeracy support before school, AM sessions with (3) TA's 2 x week (Talk Boost, comprehension, Nessy)	To improve outcomes for all pupils in school, particularly those children who are underachieving and those with SEN needs
1:1 teacher support for Literacy and Numeracy 2 x afternoon per week for focused children.	To improve outcomes for pupils in KS1 and KS2.
TA intervention group for Numeracy 4 x afternoon per week for focused children.	To improve outcomes for pupils in KS 2.
Teacher focused support 3 x mornings per week –writing and numeracy groups for higher attainers. (30 weeks)	To improve outcomes for all pupils in KS 2 in writing and numeracy results.
Cookery – 4 x afternoons per week across the school & subsidised after school cookery club in autumn, spring and summer.	To create opportunities to develop social and life skills. All children to have the opportunity to be taught basic cooking skills.
Increased MDSA support at lunchtimes	To support pupil premium children with BSED and identified needs to be able to access activities. Increase confidence and engagement in school.
Purchased books for all children linked to curriculum topic in the autumn term.	To encourage all children to read for pleasure. For all children to own their own book and encourage them to read at home with their parents/carers.
