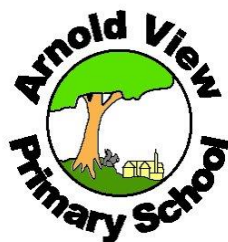

BRACKENHURST ENVIROMENTAL EDUCATION CENTRE

Class 6 & 7 visit on Thursday 28th February

Class 8 visit on Monday 4th March

We are pleased to tell you that we have been able to arrange a visit to the Brackenhurst Environmental Education Centre for the children in Lower Key Stage 2, where they will participate in a Stone Age experience day as part of an introduction to their new topic.

Class 6 & 7 will be visiting on Thursday 28th February

Class 8 will be visiting on Monday 4th March 2019

Your child will need to wear their school uniform (trousers recommended), wellies and a warm waterproof **coat**, as they will be outside for most of the day. There are indoor classrooms should the weather be really bad. We will be leaving school immediately after registration and aim to be back at school for the end of the school day at 3.30pm.

Your child will need a packed lunch and a drink, preferably in a backpack as the children will have to carry this with them all day. **If your child is entitled to Free Meals a packed lunch can be provided by Education Catering. Please indicate if you would like a lunch ordering on the slip below.**

Friends of Arnold View will be funding the transport for this visit enabling us to reduce the cost to £6.80 per child. If your child is currently in receipt of Free School Meals there is a 50% remission on this trip. The revised price of £3.40 will be reflected on the online payment system.

If you would like your child to attend, please complete the attached reply slip and return it to school. Payments are required to be made on-line through Tucasi Secure scopay.com, by Friday 8th February 2019. By making payment you are consenting for your child to take part in this visit. We will be confirming numbers with the centre on this day so it is important that we receive your payment by this date.

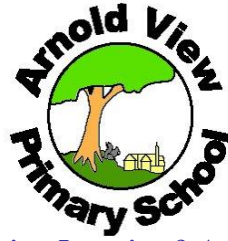

If your child uses an inhaler please ensure that this is in school ready for the visit. If your child suffers from any allergy that may be triggered by this visit please let us know on the reply slip.

We do have a limited number of spaces spare on the coach and if you would like to accompany us to Brackenhurst to help supervise the children during the visit please could you also indicate this on the consent slip and we will let you know in due course if we are able to accommodate you.
