

## Subsidised School Trips & School Funding

**School Funding has dropped considerably since the introduction of Universal Free School Meals!**

### All Children

If you are in receipt of any of the benefits detailed below you may be able to register with the Local Authority for FSM status. This would mean that your child will be entitled to free school meals and milk. School would also receive additional funding that can be used to provide resources, activities and support including subsidised trips for your child.

### Children In F1, F2 and Years 1 and 2

You need to be registered to qualify, even if your child is already receiving Universal Free Meals or your child is part-time. **Qualification would mean free meals continue into Year 3 and free milk continues beyond your child's 5th birthday.**

## Current Eligibility Criteria

### Are you in Receipt of Any of the Below?

- ◆ Income Support or Income-based Jobseekers Allowance (JSA)
- ◆ Income-related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)
- ◆ Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- ◆ The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- ◆ Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190
- ◆ Working Tax Credit run on (paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- ◆ Universal Credit—with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400
