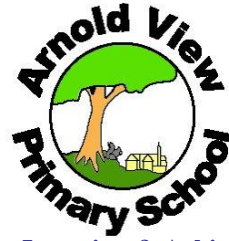

GALLERIES OF JUSTICE VISIT - CLASSES 9, 10 & 11 **Thursday 23rd May 2019**

On Thursday 23rd May, children in classes 9, 10 and 11 will be visiting the Galleries of Justice which will relate to their topic during the summer term.

The day will be split into three activities:

- Victorian CSI, where children will hunt for clues to solve the crime and meet historical characters;
- A mock trial, which the class will take part in and;
- A tour through the museum looking at crime and punishment throughout history.

We will be leaving school at approximately 9:15am and aim to be back in time for the end of the school day at 3:30pm. **Children will need to bring a packed lunch on the day, if your child is entitled to Free Meals a packed lunch can be provided by Education Catering. Please indicate if you would like a lunch ordering on the slip below.** Your child should wear their school uniform for the visit.

Friends of Arnold View will be funding the transport for this visit enabling us to reduce the cost to £12.00 per child. If your child is currently in receipt of Free School Meals there is a 50% remission on this trip. The revised price of £6.00 will be reflected on the online payment system.

If you would like your child to attend, please complete the attached reply slip and return it to school. Payments are required to be made on-line through Tucasi Secure scopay.com, by Friday 10th May 2019. By making payment you are consenting for your child to take part in this visit. We will be confirming numbers with the centre on this day so it is important that we receive your payment by this date.

If you think your child may suffer from travel sickness please could you ensure that they take a tablet for the morning journey and please provide a second tablet in an envelope clearly marked with your child's name for the return journey. If your child uses an inhaler please ensure that this is in school ready for the visit. If your child suffers from any allergy that may be triggered by this visit please let us know on the reply slip.

We do have a limited number of spaces spare on the coach and if you would like to accompany us to The Galleries of Justice to help supervise the children during the visit please could you also indicate this on the consent slip and we will let you know in due course if we are able to accommodate you.

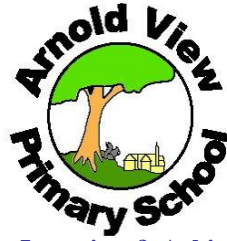
