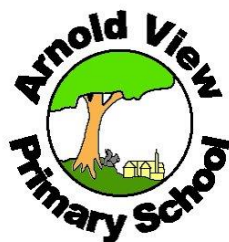

PGL – CAYTHORPE COURT VISIT

Wednesday 3rd April to Friday 5th April

Our Year 6 residential visit to Caythorpe Court is fast approaching and we thought we would take this opportunity to remind you of some essential items children may need and information for parents and carers regarding arrangements for the trip.

- Please ensure that your child has a packed lunch for the first day along with a rucksack and water bottle.
- Children may bring no more than £5 spending money which should be in a **named** purse.
- Children should not bring chocolates, sweets or other food to have in their rooms due to allergies.
- Please do not allow your child to bring electronic devices or anything precious or valuable. We suggest that children bring a **named** disposable camera should they wish to take photographs.
- Please ensure that all medicines are in a **named** container including calpol etc. which is being sent 'just in case of need' as we will not be taking any general supplies with us. Please ensure you advise us in writing if any information provided on your consent form has changed.
- Please consider any personal items which may be needed ie sanitary towels etc.
- Information from PGL has already been issued regarding kit, however, please ensure that your child also brings a towel for showering. As we will be kayaking, your child will also need a second towel and kit for this activity which should include extra trainers that you don't mind getting wet. Please ensure your child has a carrier bag to put wet clothes in.
- Bedding is required – please bring a pillow and sleeping bag or quilt.
- We would like the children to arrive early at 7.15am on the Wednesday morning, outside the main reception. We aim to leave at approximately 7.30am. We will send a parentmail message to parents once the children have arrived safely at Caythorpe Court. Please ensure you are registered to receive messages on our parentmail system and that your information is up to date.
- We aim to return to school on the Friday afternoon at 3.00pm when parents and carers can collect from the school hall.

Finally we would ask you to look at our PGL Blog on the school dojo which we will be updating regularly so that parents and carers can see what the children have been doing during the visit.
