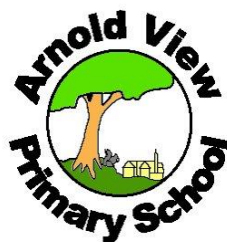

RUSHCLIFFE COUNTRY PARK VISIT – Ladybirds and F1 Afternoon Children
Wednesday 8th May 2019

We are pleased to advise that we have been able to arrange a **full day** visit to the beautiful Rushcliffe Country Park for the children in the Foundation Unit (Ladybirds & F1 Afternoon) on Wednesday 8th May 2019.

Your child will need a **coat or cagoule, sensible shoes, a hat and sun cream** if appropriate. Full time children will need to wear their school uniform. Part-time children will need to wear a long sleeved top and if possible an item of clothing that has our school logo on as this makes identifying our own children so much easier. If you do not have an item with our logo please do not buy anything especially for this trip as all children will be issued with Arnold View Identity Stickers for the duration of the visit. We will be leaving school after registration and aim to be back at school for the end of the school day at 3.30pm.

Please note, that as this is a full day, there will be no F1 Afternoon (Mrs Hutchinson) session on Tuesday 7th May.

If your child is **part-time** you will need to provide them with a packed lunch and sufficient drinks for the day, preferably in a back pack for them to carry with them. If your child is **full-time** they will be provided with a free packed lunch for the visit which will consist of a Sandwich, Fruit Bag, Yoghurt and a cake. Drinks will **not** be included with lunch, therefore, please can you send your child with sufficient drinks for the day in a back pack for them to carry with them. Full-time children will be asked in school which sandwich filling they would like for the visit from a choice of cheese, ham or jam. You are also welcome to provide your child with some additional healthy snacks to supplement their lunch if you wish. Children who normally have school milk will receive their milk on arrival at Rushcliffe Country Park.

Friends of Arnold View will be funding part of the visit enabling us to reduce the cost to **£3.80 per child**. If your child is currently in receipt of Free School Meals there is a 50% remission on this trip. The revised price of £1.90 will be reflected on the online payment system.

Please complete the attached reply slip and return it to school. Payments are required to be made on-line through Tucasi Secure scopay.com, by Friday 5th April 2019. By making payment you are consenting for your child to take part in this visit.

If you think your child may suffer from travel sickness please could you ensure that they take a tablet for the morning journey and please provide a second tablet in an envelope clearly marked with your child's name for the return journey. If your child uses an inhaler please ensure that this is in school ready for the visit. If your child suffers from any allergy that may be triggered by this visit please let us know on the reply slip.

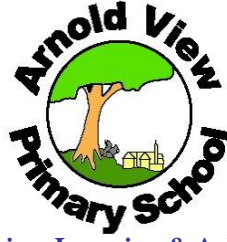
