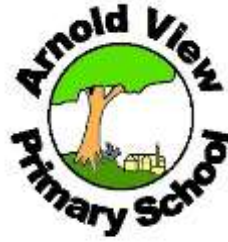

**OPAL Club with parents – F2 to Year 6 ONLY**  
**Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> June to Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> July**

We are pleased to inform you that the F2 team will be running an OPAL club for **children and their parents** in the second half of the Summer Term. The club will take place outside on Tuesday evenings from 3:30pm to 4:30pm starting on 10<sup>th</sup> June to 8<sup>th</sup> July. The club is for parents to come along and play with their child outside in our wonderful OPAL environment. OPAL play includes an element of “risky play” and the children have already taken part in “risk benefit assessments” which enable them to manage the element of risk, to make play as safe as possible. These will be shared with you on the first week and then available each week with relevant activities.

The number of places available is limited, so please complete and return the link asap and the school will advise you via e-mail if your child has been successful in obtaining a place in the club.

Should you and your child be successful in obtaining a place in the club please can you ensure that you both have sensible shoes along with a water bottle on the day. Please note you will be responsible for the safety of you and your child. Please remember that you must not use your mobile phone for any purpose when on the school site. Staff members will be on site to guide you. If the weather turns inclement, the club will be cancelled on the morning it is due to take place and you will be notified by text (please call the office to confirm receipt of this text on the day). Please note that, in line with our uniform policy, children will not be permitted to wear any kind of jewellery during the club.

**As with all activities in school we expect the highest standards of behaviour from the children at all times. Please could you instil in your child the importance of this and explain that should their behaviour be unacceptable then they may not be allowed to participate in these sessions. We would expect the selected children and parents to attend all the sessions if possible.**
