Key vocabulary

- **Dilemma** - A tough choice. When you're in a difficult situation and each option looks equally bad, you're in a dilemma.
- **Justice** - Fairness in the way that people are dealt with.
- **Zakat** - To purify or cleanse your wealth by sharing it with the needy. It is the third pillar of Islam.
- **Agnostic** - If someone believes they cannot know whether or not God exists.
- **Compassion** - When we care about others, treat them with kindness and feel a strong desire to help people in need.
