# Banksy - Sketching

## Key Vocabulary



- **Tone** - The lightness or darkness of a colour.
- **Pencil Grade** - The pencil's grade tells you how light/dark it is.
- **Shading** - Using techniques such as hatching or cross-hatching to create darker tones (shadows) and add dimension.
- **Proportion** - Keeping everything the correct size in comparison to the other parts.
- **Perspective** - Drawing techniques that make artwork appear 3D.
- **Horizon Line** - a horizontal line where the earth meets the sky from which perspective lines can be drawn.



## Sticky Knowledge



- Banksy's art reflects his feelings about today's world and it criticises the way things currently are.
- He uses spray paint and stencils to create his designs.
- He paints onto public buildings so the world can see his designs and understand his messages.
- H pencils create lighter tones and B pencils create darker tones.
- Adding perspective to 2D art makes it appear like it's 3D.
