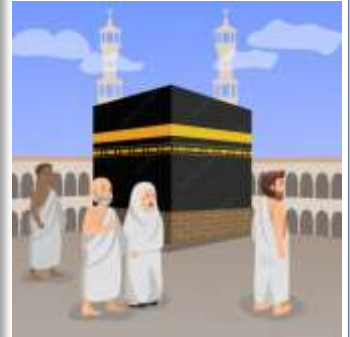

Key vocabulary

- **Spirituality** - A recognition of a feeling or sense or belief that there is something greater than ourselves.
- **Pilgrim** - A person who makes a long journey to a foreign land, sometimes for religious reasons.
- **Ritual**- A ceremony or action performed in a customary way
- **Values** - These are the beliefs that each person considers are important for themselves and possibly humanity as a whole.
- **Commitment**- Doing what needs to be done regardless of your talents or moods.
