Key vocabulary

- **Trinity** - A way of describing God the father, God the son and God the holy spirit.
- **Spiritual** - A sense of awe and wonder or a care for nature and living things.
- **Ritual**- A ceremony or action, performed in a customary way.
- **Commitment** - Doing something that needs to be done, regardless of your talent or mood.
- **Sacred** - Something that is worthy of religious worship and very holy.



Sticky knowledge

Year 4

- Use religious vocabulary to describe key features in the church and Christian activities at the different forms of church on Sundays.
- Describe the different expressions of Christian worship.
- Describe the Christian involvement in the community.
- Make links between Jesus' teachings and the way Christians help in community projects.
- Consider questions at the church. Discuss and give thoughtful responses to them.
- Make links between the importance of their special place and church as a special place for Christians.
- Make links between their values and those of people with a Christian faith.
