Key vocabulary

- **Reggae** - popular music of Jamaican origin that is performed with the accent on the offbeat (beats 2 and 4).
- **Beats** - a steady pulse
- **Bar** - a small segment of a piece of music that contains a certain number of beats.
- **Accent** - accenting a note is when the player plays a note stronger than the other notes.
- **Silence** - when there is no noise.
