philosophy - a theory or attitude that acts as a guiding principle for behaviour.

Athenians - a native or citizen of Athens.

Spartans Sparta was a prominent city-state in Laconia in ancient Greece

democracy - A system where the citizens of a country or state are involved in the way it is run.

Zeus - the supreme god of the ancient Greeks, who became ruler of gods and men

Olympics - the ancient Olympic Games were primarily a part of a religious festival in honor of Zeus, the father of the Greek gods and goddesses.

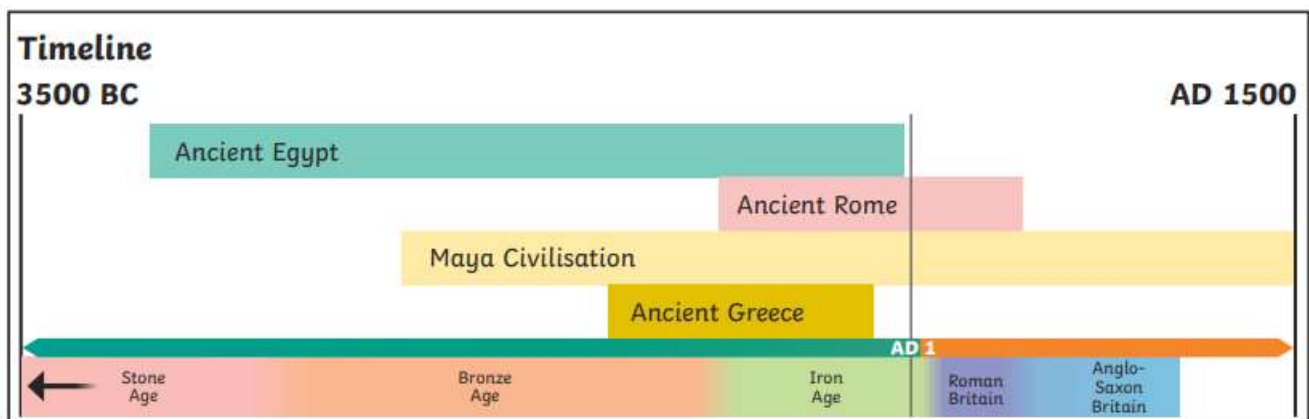
