The Deserts

Key vocabulary

Desert - A desert biome is an area that receives less than 25cm of rainfall each year.

Biome - a large region of Earth that has a certain climate and certain types of living things.

Precipitation - any form of water being transferred from the air to the ground, for example, rain, snow and mist.

Biodiversity - the variety of life in one area including plants and animals.

Adaptation - animals and plants that adjusted to have special features that help them to survive.
