## Belonging

### Key vocabulary



- **Worship** - To honour or respect as a divine being.
- **Belonging** - Feeling a close or intimate relationship and a sense of purpose.
- **Baptism** - A ceremony that symbolises a commitment to living life as a Christian.
- **Christening** - A type of baptism in the Christian or Anglican church. Commonly babies and young children are baptised,
- **Religious Artefact** - An item that is used for a religious purpose.

#### Year 2

- Retell how a baby is baptised.
- Identify ways of belonging for Christians, such as wearing symbols, or being baptised.
- Talk about and give opinions about ways that animals and people in groups make harmonious relationships.
- Talk about ways of behaving and rules that make a home/ school happier and talk about the value of saying sorry.
- Respond sensitively in the Christening experience and to discussions on baptism.
