Jewish Creation to Shabbat

Key vocabulary



- **Shabbat** - Shabbat is the Jewish day of rest and happens every week from sunset on Friday to sunset On Saturday.
- **Creation Story** - A symbolic story of how the world began and how people first came to inhabit it.
- **Promises** - A statement that something absolutely will happen or be done.
- **Challah** - Braided bread that is a typical Shabbat food and is blessed before the meal begins.
- **Menorah** - A candelabra used in Jewish worship.
