Key vocabulary

- **Pulse**-the steady beat in a piece of music
- **Rhythm**-short and longer sounds that are put together
- **Pitch**- how high or low a sound is
- **Improvise**- to make up a tune and play it on the spot
- **Compose**- to write music
- **Audience**-the people listening and watching
- **Melody**-another name for tune
- **Dynamics**-how quietly or loudly music is played
- **Tempo**-the speed of the music
- **Unison** - when everyone is singing at the same time
- **Rock**- a genre of music that originated in the USA
