Visiting A Church

Key vocabulary

- **Pew** - One of the benches with backs and sometimes doors set in rows in a church.
- **Altar** - An altar is a raised area in a house of worship where people can honour God with offerings.
- **Symbol**-A religious symbol is an iconic representation or object intended to represent a religion or a certain concept within a given religion.
- **Peace** - Living in harmony and not fighting with others.
- **Worship** - Worship is telling and showing God you love him by praying, singing songs, learning, believing and talking about God.
