Jewish Stories

Key vocabulary

- **Jewish**- Judaism is the religion of the Jewish people. Judaism teaches that a person serves God by learning the holy books and doing what they teach.
- **Torah** - In Hebrew this can mean teaching, direction, guidance and law. The Torah contains the first five books of the Hebrew Bible.
- **Obedience**- An act or instance of obeying and immediately doing what you are told.
- **Faith** - Belief and trust in and loyalty to God.
- **Forgiveness** -An intentional decision to let go of resentment and anger.
