Ocean - a large area of sea

Sea - smaller than oceans and are usually located where the land and ocean meet.

Continent - a very large area of land that includes all of the islands with it.

Island - an area of land surrounded by water.

Land - part of the Earth's surface not covered in water.

Country nation with its own government, occupying a particular territory.

Map - representation of a place

Globe - spherical model of the earth.

World Oceans

There are five **oceans** in the world:
