## Jesus And His Stories

### Key vocabulary



- **Parable**- A simple story that has a religious or moral meaning at the end.
- **Religion**- Belief in a God or Gods and the activities that are connected with this belief such as praying or worshipping in a building such as a church or a temple.
- **Faith** - Believing that what God says, he will do. Being confidently sure about something even if you cannot see it.
- **God** - A supreme being or deity that people who follow a religion worship.
- **Belief** - An idea one accepts as being true or real.

- Talk about such values as helping others, being sorry for things you have done, forgiveness.
