Key vocabulary



Country - nation with its own government, occupying a particular territory.

Continent - a very large area of land that includes all of the islands with it.

Weather - describes the day-to-day condition of the atmosphere.

Climate - means the average weather conditions in a particular location based on the average weather experienced there over 30 years or more

Diet - the combination of foods typically eaten by a specific group of people

Wildlife - living things and especially mammals, birds, and fishes that are neither human nor domesticated.

Drought - a period of time when an area or region experiences below-normal precipitation.

Government - the group of people with the authority to govern a country or state; a particular ministry in office.
