## Timbre! (Musical Me)

### Key vocabulary

- **Melody** - tune
- **Notation** - how music is written down
- **Accompaniment** - playing instruments along with a song
- **Pitch** - how high or low a note is
- **Timbre** - the quality of a sound (different instruments playing the same note, still sound different)
- **Dynamics** - how loud or quiet the music is

### Sticky knowledge/Skills

\*A Melody is a 'tune.'

\*A melody is made up from high and low-pitched notes played one after the other, making a tune.

\*Notation means writing music down so that someone else can play it.

\*An accompaniment can mean playing instruments along with a song.

\* 'Timbre' means the quality of a sound; e.g. that different instruments would sound different playing a note of the same pitch.
