Graphic Scores! (Myths and Legends)

Key vocabulary

- **Graphic Score** - a way of representing musical sounds by using symbols or pictures.
- **Texture** - the different layers that make up the music.
- **Structure** - the different sections that make up a piece of music.
- **Symphonic Poem** - a composition written for an orchestra which represents a story or a picture.
