Visiting A Synagogue

Key vocabulary

- **Rabbi** - A spiritual leader or religious teacher of a Jewish community or congregation.
- **Shawl** - A square or oblong piece of woven or knitted fabric used especially as a covering for the head or shoulders.
- **Star Of David** - A 6 pointed star used as a symbol of Judaism.
- **Sacred** - Means holy and devoted to a religious ceremony or deity or simply something worthy of awe or respect.
- **Kipah** - A brimless cap made of cloth, traditionally worn by Jewish males to cover their heads which is required in a Jewish ceremony.
