

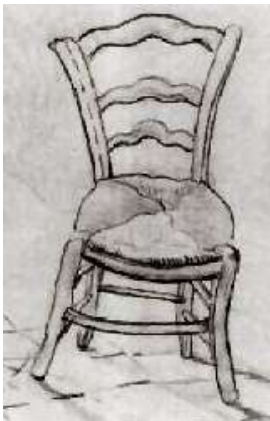

Vincent Van Gogh - Sketching

Key Vocabulary



- **Expressionism** - Art where the details are changed to show the artist's inner feelings or ideas.
- **Sketching** - Pressing lightly with the pencil to make small marks.
- **Tone** - The lightness or darkness of a colour.
- **Pencil Grade** - How light or dark the tone of the pencil is (H pencils are lighter and B pencils are darker).
- **Shading** - Using darker pencils or pressing harder with the pencil to create shadows.
- **Proportion** - Keeping everything in the picture the correct size.



Sticky Knowledge



- Vincent Van Gogh was an expressionist artist from the Netherlands.
- Expressionism is art where details have been changed to show the artist's inner feelings and ideas.
- He used bold brush strokes which show emotion or movement.
- B pencils create darker tones and H pencils create lighter tones.
- Pressing harder with the pencil creates darker tones and pressing lightly creates lighter tones.
