Vincent Scarpace - Printing

Key Vocabulary

- **Abstract** - Art that does not try to look like the real thing by using different colours or shapes to change how it looks.
- **Artist** - A person who makes music, paintings, clay models and more.
- **Swirls** - a line that curls around into a spiral pattern.
- **Cross-hatching** - Adding shade by drawing lines crossing over the top each other.
- **Proportion** - checking the size of each part is in relation to each other.
- **Size** - How big or small something is.
- **Blended Colour** - When 2 colours are mixed together.
- **Faded Colour** - When you use different tints of the same colour until it fades to white



Sticky Knowledge

- J. Vincent Scarpace is an artist from New York, USA.
- Abstract art does not look realistic. J. Vincent Scarpace changed the colours, shapes and sizes of what he drew to make them look like fantasy creatures.
- Scarpace uses dots, swirls, cross-hatching and an oversized eye in his art. These are his signature techniques.
- Creating a print tile will require sketching out our patterns, gluing string carefully along the sketched lines before adding paint to our tiles and printing onto paper.



Timeline of his life:



1971
Born in Buffalo, New York in the USA.

1970s
Scarpace grew up with artistic parents who encouraged him to paint and draw and work with clay.

2003
Scarpace finished university where he studied art to become an artist.

2000s
Scarpace became an art teacher and enjoyed sharing his skills with others.

2010s
He decided to become a full-time artist and paint fish in own unique, abstract style.

2022
Today his work is in galleries in over 40 countries around the world and in all 50 states of the USA.
