## Brave People In The Bible

### Key vocabulary

- **Anointing** - To smear or rub with oil as part of a religious ceremony.
- **Faith** - Trusting in someone or something - Faith in God is believing that He can and will do all that He has promised.
- **Old Testament**- In Christianity the Old Testament is the name of the first part of the Bible which was completed before Jesus Christ was born.
- **Persistence** - Not giving up when facing a challenge.
- **Obedience** - People demonstrate obedience when they follow the law and children show obedience when they obey their parents or teachers. It is a sign of respect.
