Leonardo Da Vinci - Sketching

Key Vocabulary



- **Renaissance** - An art movement from 600 years ago that focused on creating realistic work that was true to life.
- **Sketching** - Pressing lightly with the pencil to make small marks.
- **Pencil Grade** - The pencil's grade tells you how light or dark it is.
- **Shading** - Adding darker parts to your drawing to show where the shadows are (this helps it to look more 3D).
- **Proportion** - Keeping everything the correct size in comparison to the other parts.
- **Tone** - the degree of lightness or darkness in the drawing.



Sticky Knowledge



- Leonardo Da Vinci was a painter, engineer, scientist, sculptor and architect who came from Italy.
- He was a renaissance artist which meant he created realistic artwork that was true to life.
- His art focused on careful observations of nature, architecture, mechanics and his own inventions.
