Key vocabulary



Country - An area of land with its own government, rules and borders
The United Kingdom. It is made up of four countries: England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland.

European Union (EU) - a group of 27 countries formed to bring the countries together.

France - a country in western Europe.

Europe - Europe is a continent made up of 27 countries.

Continent - a large solid area of land made up of a group of countries.

Mediterranean - This biogeographical region includes the Mediterranean Sea and seven countries (France, Portugal, Italy, Spain, Greece, Malta, Cyprus).

English Channel - The **English Channel**, also known as simply the Channel is an arm of the Atlantic Ocean that separates Southern England from northern France.



Sticky knowledge

- Both the UK and France are in Europe; the UK is slightly north of France, across the English Channel.
- France is on mainland Europe, The UK isn't.
- Slightly more people live in France. 67 million people live in France compared with 66 million in the UK.
- London and Paris are similar in size.
