Hindu Worship and Easter 3

Key vocabulary



- **Hindu** - A person who adheres to the religion of Hinduism.
- **Murti** - A sacred Hindu statue of a God or Goddess.
- **Puja**- Praying to an image or statue of a deity and giving offerings to that deity.
- **Mandir** - A Hindu temple and place of worship.
- **Artefact** - A man made object such as pieces of art or tools that is of particular historical, cultural or archaeological interest.

- Retell some stories that Hindus tell.
- Start to understand that Hindus believe in one God, Brahman, whose characteristics are represented by different gods.
- Identify some puja artefacts used in Hindu worship and recognise the importance of worship at home for Hindus.
- Recall that Hindus worship at home and at the temple.
- Ask questions and respond sensitively to Hindus and other people's views about God and worship.
- Identify what they find important in their lives.
