Key vocabulary

- **Trinity** - A way of describing God the father, God the son and God the holy spirit.
- **Spiritual** - A sense of awe and wonder or a care for nature and living things.
- **Ritual**- A ceremony or action, performed in a customary way.
- **Commitment** - Doing something that needs to be done, regardless of your talent or mood.
- **Sacred** - Something that is worthy of religious worship and very holy.

Year 3

- Identify how Christian worship can be expressed in some different ways.
- Identify some Christian involvement in the community.
