Instruction – Information about how something should be done.

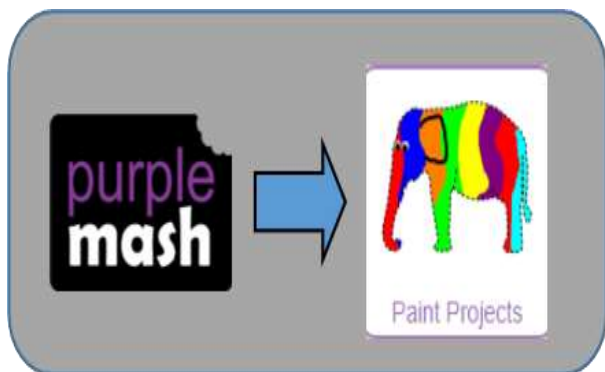
Algorithm – A precise, step-by-step set of instructions used to solve a problem or achieve an objective.

Debug – To find and remove errors from computer hardware or software.
