- Present - the word present is used to describe things or people that are around now.
- Modern - related to present time.
- Victorian - Victorian means items used or events which happened when Queen Victoria was on the throne.
- Manufactured - To manufacture something means to make it in a factory, usually in large quantities.
- Homemade - Something that is homemade has been made in someone's home, rather than in a store or factory.



Sticky knowledge

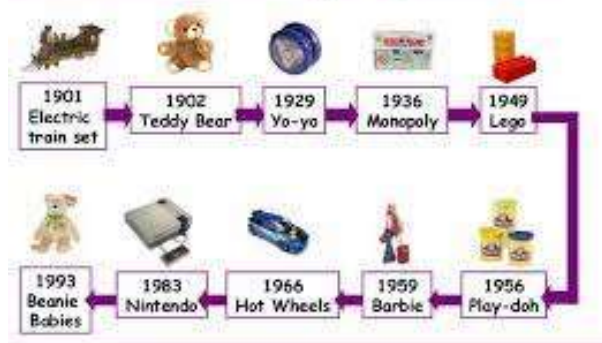
- Dolls are one of the earliest forms of toys to exist.
