Key Vocabulary

- **Conceptual Art** - Artwork that has a meaning or makes you feel an emotion when you look at it.
- **Polka Dots** - A pattern that is made using lots of circles that are coloured in with one colour.
- **Repetition** - Doing the same shape/pattern over and over again.
- **Camouflage** - blending into your surroundings.
- **Printing** - Transferring an image from one surface to another.
- **Template** - A guide for you to draw or cut around so that you get the correct shape.



Sticky Knowledge

- Yayoi Kusama is a painter and sculptor from Japan.
- She is a conceptual artist which means that the message behind the art, or how you feel when you look at it, is more important than what it actually looks like.
- She always uses bright, vibrant colours and will often use polka dot patterns.
- She uses repetition in her work to make it seem endless.
