Key vocabulary

- **Belief** - A feeling sure that someone or something exists.
- **Parable** - A simple story that has a special religious or moral meaning at the end.
- **Faith** - Belief and trust in a loyalty to God.
- **Symbol** - Something that stands for something else, especially: something real that stands for or suggest another thing cannot in itself be pictured or shown.
- **Bible** - A group of religious texts that show Gods message to Christians.
