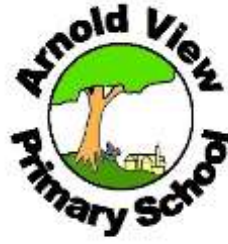

KNIFE CRIME EXHIBIT @ NATIONAL JUSTICE MUSEUM - CLASS 9 **Tuesday 3rd June**

We have been lucky to be given a place to visit the knife crime exhibition at the National Justice Museum on the afternoon of Tuesday 3rd June.

The purpose of the session is to explore children's views and exposure to knife crime and how early education on the subject can have a positive effect. LBC will be trying to get a sense of children's attitudes to knife crime and carrying knives, before and after seeing the exhibit, and how the experience has changed their views. A few children, along with a member of school and museum staff, will be asked to take part in an audio interview which will be included in regional bulletins on LBC news (no children's information will be shared). Please indicate on the link below if you are happy for your child to take part in this interview.

The children will be getting to and from the Museum via public transport escorted by school staff. The children will be leaving school around 11.15am and will be back at school around 3.35pm. We will be catching the No 59 bus outside school (no bus fare will be required). Your child will need a packed lunch and a drink, preferably in a backpack on the day. **If your child is entitled to Free School Meals a packed lunch can be provided by Education Catering. Please indicate if you would like a lunch ordering on the below forms.**

We are pleased to advise you that there is no charge for this visit, but for your child to take part you need to complete the below forms link by Monday 12th May.

Children should wear their uniform for this visit and have the appropriate coat/hat/sun cream for the weather. If your child suffers from any allergy that may be triggered by this visit please let us know on the consent form.
