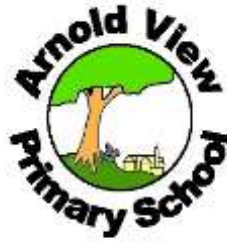

Dear Parents/Carers

## **Year 4 – Residential Visit to Willersley Castle, Matlock Monday 10<sup>th</sup> November to Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> November**

Thank you for attending the meeting for our forthcoming Willersley Castle visit in November.

**The cost of the visit will be £165.00 per child – this price could reduce slightly depending on numbers and will be reflected in your final payment on our Scopay system.** Remember that this cost includes all transport to and from the centre, all accommodation costs, all meal costs and costs for support staff from Willersley Castle. If your child is currently in receipt of income based free school meals, then you will be entitled to a subsidy which will reflect on your on-line payment schedule. Please enquire at the office if you would like further information. We do not charge for the cost of school staff/volunteers as their time is given voluntarily.

**Can you please confirm your child's place with an initial non-refundable deposit of £30.00 by Friday 31<sup>st</sup> January.. Payments are required to be made on-line through [Secure scopay.com](https://www.scopay.com).**

The remaining amount can be paid in three equal payments of £45.00 due by 28<sup>th</sup> March, 30<sup>th</sup> May and 25<sup>th</sup> July. If you wish to pay smaller amounts more regularly, please feel free to do so as long as the **full payment is made by the 25<sup>th</sup> July**. Should you wish to pay an amount in full, this is also a possibility.

We would like to remind you that this opportunity of an activity visit is a very valuable experience for your child. Our past experience has shown that the children become much more independent, their confidence increases and they develop a very different working relationship with the school staff. We would encourage all children to take part in this visit and please take into account that by the time the visit arrives your children will be older than at the present time.

We will arrange another meeting in the autumn to discuss the finer details including a kit list and other relevant information you will need prior to our visit. You will also need to complete a medical and consent form which will be sent out closer to the trip date.
