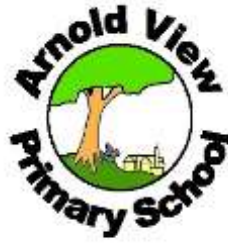

Dear Parents/Carers

VEOLIA RECYCLING CENTRE VISIT - Wed 26th March, Thu 27th March or Fri 28th March

We are pleased to tell you that we have been able to arrange a visit to the Veolia recycling centre for the children in Upper Key Stage 2, which links nicely with our sustainability and environment topic.

Class 11 children will be visiting on Wednesday 26th March

Class 9 children will be visiting on Thursday 27th March

Class 10 children will be visiting on Friday 28th March

Your child will need to wear their school uniform (trousers recommended), sensible shoes and a warm waterproof **coat**, as they will be outside for most of the day. We will be leaving school immediately after registration and aim to be back at school for around 1.00pm and your child will need a packed lunch and a drink, preferably in a backpack. **If your child is entitled to Free Meals a packed lunch can be provided by Education Catering. Please indicate if you would like a lunch ordering on the below forms.**

Most of the trip will be subsidised by Veolia but we will need a payment of £5.00 towards part of the transport cost. Unfortunately, if we do not receive enough funds this trip may not be able to take place.

For your child to take part in this visit, please complete the below forms link asap AND make your payment. Your forms consent and payments (to be made on-line through Secure scopay.com,) are required by Friday 14th February. We will be confirming numbers with Veolia on this day so it is important that we receive your consent and payment by this date.
