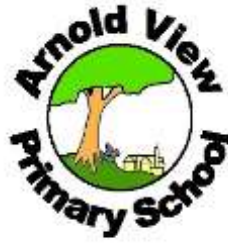

**Year 4 – Residential Visit to Willersley Castle, Matlock  
Monday 10<sup>th</sup> November to Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> November**

## **Important Information Meeting – Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> January @ 3.45pm in Class 7**

Next school year we are planning to take the current Year 3 children on a residential visit to Willersley Castle, Cromford, Matlock. The visit will take place from the morning of Monday 10<sup>th</sup> November to Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> November.

This is our first residential at Willersley and after visiting the Castle recently we are very excited that we can offer this experience to all our Year 4 children. Willersley Castle provides a safe and secure environment for schools to enjoy outdoor pursuits. The centre operates within a very compact central area with the majority of the activities taken place within 10 acres. As usual the school will commit a large number of its own staff to the visit who will work in conjunction with the centre staff.

We will be able to confirm the cost of the trip in the New Year. The cost of the trip will include all transport to and from the centre, all accommodation costs, all meal costs and all costs for support staff from Willersley Castle. If your child is currently in receipt of income based free school meals, then you will be entitled to a subsidy which will reflect on your on-line payment schedule. We do not charge for the cost of school staff/volunteers as their time is given voluntarily.

We will advise you of the payment plan after the meeting and then arrange another meeting in the summer to discuss the finer details including a kit list and other relevant information you will need prior to our visit.

This opportunity of an activity visit is a very valuable experience for your child. Our past experience has shown that the children become much more independent, their confidence increases and they develop a very different working relationship with the school staff. We would encourage all parents no matter how unsure you may be about your child's ability to cope to come along to the meeting in order to talk to staff and other parents. Please take into account that by the time the visit arrives your children will be older than at the present time.
