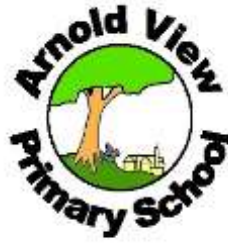

Dear Parents/Carers

Stonebridge City Farm Visit – Ladybirds & Busy Bees - Wednesday 23rd April 2025

In the Summer term, F2 (Reception) children will be learning about how animals grow and change. We would love to take the children on a trip to Stonebridge City Farm in Nottingham on **Wednesday 23rd April** to launch our topic. During our trip, we will get a guided tour of the farm, get to feed some of the animals and enjoy a picnic lunch. It is a great opportunity for children to make real life links to their learning in school.

Your child will need to wear their school uniform (trousers recommended), wellies and either a warm waterproof coat, or sun hat and sun cream (weather appropriate). We would appreciate it if he/she could wear an item of clothing that has our school logo on as this makes identifying our own children so much easier. We will be leaving school after registration and will return for the end of the school day at 3.30pm.

The cost of the trip, including the transport is £13.50 per child which can be paid either in full or in 3 monthly instalments. **The first instalment of £5.50 needs to be paid by Fri 17th Jan and then two £4.00 payments due by 14th Feb & 14th Mar. Payments are required to be made on-line via **Secure scopay.com**.** For those parents in receipt of income based free school meals, a reduced price will be shown on the Scopay system. Unfortunately, if we do not receive enough funds this trip will not be able to take place.

For your child to attend, please complete the attached forms link AND make your full/first payment by Friday 17th January. We will be confirming numbers with the centre on this day so it is important that we receive your consent and payment by this date so we can confirm that the trip can take place.

Your child will be provided with a free packed lunch for the visit which will consist of a wholemeal roll (filling choice of ham, cheese or tuna mayo), crisp, fruit and a muffin. Please provide a drink and any additional healthy snacks if required in a back pack for them to carry with them. They will receive their school milk as normal on this day.

If you think your child may suffer from travel sickness please ensure that they take a tablet for the morning journey and provide the teacher with a second tablet, clearly marked, for the return journey. If your child uses an inhaler please ensure that this is in school ready for the visit. If your child suffers from any allergy that may be triggered by this visit please let us know on the reply forms link.

We will need a certain number of adults to accompany us to Stonebridge City Farm to help supervise the children during the visit. Please could you indicate if you would like to help on the consent form and we will let you know in due course if we are able to accommodate you.
